All primary sources volumes include 18 selections (both print selections including speeches, legislation, poems, etc., and illustrations such as political cartoons, maps, and theater plans). These are introduced by explanatory material and a bulleted list of brief descriptions of social and political conditions that establish historical context. Documents are followed by "Did you know" sections containing peripheral facts (for example, a first-class ticket on the Titanic cost the present-day equivalent of \$50,000) and "Consider the following" sections listing several queries or suggestions for study. Technical vocabulary and period references are defined in outer margins, adjacent to the original text. All volumes offer numerous inserts and sidebars, black-and-white illustrations, archival photos, and reproductions, all with detailed captions. Individual entry bibliographies are divided into lists of print and online resources. A reader's guide, time lines, glossaries, comprehensive "Where to Learn More" resource lists, and volume-specific indexes are also provided.
